Operating Unit Overview

OU Executive Summary

Background

Zambia continues to face a health, economic development and humanitarian crisis as a result of the HIV and AIDS epidemic. The *2007 Zambia Demographic and Health Survey (2007 ZDHS)* estimates that 14 percent of Zambians aged 15-49 are HIV positive. Heterosexual intercourse and vertical transmission from mother-to-child are the primary causes of HIV transmission. Multiple concurrent sexual relationships, gender inequality, alcohol and substance abuse and sexual violence fuel HIV transmission. An estimated 11 percent of cohabitating couples in Zambia are sero-discordant. High risk groups (including HIV discordant couples, commercial sex workers and their clients and partners, long distance truck drivers, agricultural workers, miners, and members of the uniformed services) need greater attention if the country is to halve incidence in accordance with national plans.

Women account for over half of the country's HIV infections. HIV prevalence is 16 percent among women compared to 12 percent among men (*2007 ZDHS*). Numerous factors including economic status, biology and physiology, and social/cultural norms contribute to this gender bias in HIV infection. In Zambia, domestic violence occurs across all socio-economic and cultural backgrounds. The *2007 ZDHS* estimates that 47 percent of women aged 15–49 have experienced physical violence at some point in their lives, while one in every five women (20 percent) in the same age group have experienced sexual violence.

Four in ten Zambian children under the age of 18 are living in households without both parents; translating to approximately 1.2 million orphans, the preponderance due to HIV (*2007 ZDHS*). Children living with chronically ill parents or caregivers experience significant hardships as serious illnesses limit the availability of household resources needed to feed, clothe and educate them. These children are also at greater risk of dropping out of school.

Chronic human resource shortages, limited local capacity and, more recently, public financial management challenges hamper Zambia's HIV and AIDS response. The Government of the Republic of Zambia (GRZ) is focusing on increasing the number of trained health workers in both clinical and community settings while identifying and supporting local groups to expand capacity for the national HIV and AIDS response.

Country Ownership and Sustainability

PEPFAR Zambia's 2011 Country Operational Plan (COP) was developed under the rubric of the Partnership Framework. The Partnership Framework, currently being finalized, supports the goals and objectives of the Zambian national response to HIV and AIDS as articulated in the draft *National AIDS Strategic Framework 2011-2015 (NASF 2011-2015)* and the draft *National Health Strategic Plan (NHSP 2011-2015)*. The overarching vision of the GRZ, and thus the GRZ/USG Partnership Framework, is a nation free from the threat of HIV and AIDS with the goal of reducing new HIV infections by 50 percent by 2015. This COP embodies the spirit of the GRZ/USG Partnership Framework and moves towards greater country leadership, recognizing that many programs are years away from transitioning to full country ownership and financial operation. COP 2011 PEPFAR Zambia activities will equip the GRZ, civil society and private sector partners with the necessary tools to lead and manage the HIV and AIDS response into the future.

The five key objectives of the GRZ/USG Partnership Framework which form the basis of Zambia's COP 2011 are drawn from the *NASF 2011-2015* and *NHSP 2011-2015*. They are:



- i. To accelerate and intensify prevention in order to reduce the annual rate of new HIV infections;
- ii. To accelerate the provision of universal access to comprehensive and quality treatment, care and support for people living with HIV and AID, their caregivers and their families, including services for tuberculosis (TB), sexually transmitted infections (STIs) and other opportunistic infections (OIs);
- iii. To mitigate the socio-economic impacts of HIV and AIDS especially among the most vulnerable groups, orphans and vulnerable children (OVC), people living with HIV and AIDS (PLHA) and their caregivers and families;
- iv. To strengthen the systems which underpin Zambia's response to HIV and AIDS; and
- v. To strengthen the capacity for a well coordinated and sustainably managed HIV and AIDS multi-sectoral response.

During FY 2011, the GRZ will continue to strengthen the facility and community- based HIV and AIDS response via a decentralized approach from the central to the provincial, district and community levels, and will also enhance monitoring, evaluation, and research. With COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will provide many of the resources required for continued systems strengthening as well as HIV and AIDS service delivery. The majority of PEPFAR Zambia program implementation will continue to take place in public facilities under the auspices of the GRZ; although, partnerships with the private sector and civil society organizations (CSOs) will expand.

Prevention

PEPFAR prevention programs support Zambia's goals to reduce the rate of annual new HIV infections from 1.6 percent to below 0.8 percent in adults by 2015 (82,000 annual new infections to 40,000); and to reduce the number of infected infants born to HIV positive mothers to less than 5 percent¹ by 2015.

The GRZ and PEPFAR Zambia are focusing on reducing the risk of HIV infection through changes in sexual behaviors, addressing social norms such as gender based violence (GBV), the scale up of biomedical interventions such as blood safety, the prevention of mother-to-child transmission (PMTCT) and male circumcision (MC). Specific interventions target most at risk populations (MARPS) and other vulnerable groups with increased focus on the epidemic drivers and harmful social and gender norms that fuel the spread of HIV and AIDS.

Broad efforts include the expansion of evidence-based prevention for youth; expansion of STI prevention through condom promotion, messaging about safer sexual practices and STI diagnosis and treatment; addressing alcohol abuse; expansion of couples testing and counseling (TC); integration of HIV prevention messaging and counseling into other health activities (e.g. family planning (FP) and child health); prevention with PLHA; and discordant couples counseling regarding prevention and condom use. Providers will use diagnostic TC for patients who are at risk of contracting HIV or are uncertain of their HIV status. USG funded programs will mobilize political and traditional leaders, including religious leaders and local chiefs, to lead HIV prevention efforts in their communities.

Activities targeting prevention with positives (PwP) will receive more attention in the coming year. PwP programs are crucial for improved disease outcomes for PLHA, reduced transmission from PLHA to HIV negative individuals and for prevention of HIV in sero-discordant couples. PwP activities include behavioral counseling, condom distribution, partner testing, FP counseling and services, antiretroviral therapy (ART) adherence support, and screening and treatment of STIs. Routine HIV testing and counseling, ANC and other health services will integrate PwP activities when patient HIV status is known.

The GRZ is committed to virtual elimination of mother to child HIV transmission by 2015 and has launched new guidelines for PMTCT to address all four prongs of the global PMTCT strategy. In FY 2011, PMTCT plus-up funding from COP 2010 will strengthen infrastructure, increase availability of anti-retroviral drugs (ARVs) for mothers and their infants, and promote both clinical and community activities that are key to the virtual elimination of pediatric HIV. PEPFAR Zambia will intensify efforts to raise the HIV testing rates of pregnant women and their partners through community approaches and facility practices. Community compacts will be established which provide additional support and incentive in reaching 95 percent testing in pregnant women and 80 percent partner testing. Given the higher risk of HIV infection during pregnancy and lactation, there will be an increased focus on re-testing of women who tested negative on the initial visit, through the period of pregnancy, labor and delivery and lactation. PEPFAR will also strengthen PMTCT systems to provide timely access to ART to at least 61,000 HIV-infected pregnant women. PEPFAR Zambia has programmed over \$34 million in COP 2011 to reach HIV positive pregnant women and their HIV exposed infants with more efficacious PMTCT regimens. PEPFAR Zambia will procure PMTCT-related drugs and laboratory commodities through the central logistics and supply system. In addition, PMTCT plus-up funds will strengthen the continuum of care and support for mother-baby pairs through the integration of HIV and child health clinical and community based services.

Male circumcision is receiving widespread support as a national prevention strategy. PEPFAR Zambia is supporting the scale up of MC services targeting HIV-negative males between the ages of 15 and 49 years, including those in multiple concurrent as well as sero-discordant partnerships. Barriers to MC include access to services; cultural beliefs, commodities and supplies, and trained health workers. PEPFAR Zambia will address these barriers through a comprehensive approach including behavior change communications (BCC) interventions, referrals from HIV TC, ART and STI services; couples counseling; provider training; the provision of commodities and supplies; and establishing new MC sites. During COP 2011, the target for the number of males circumcised as part of the minimum package of MC is 66,227.

Care and Support

As of March 2010, a total of 630,000 Zambians accessed different types of HIV and AIDS care and support services. In COP 2011, PEPFAR care and support activities will prioritize early identification of HIV-infected persons and linkages to other services such as PMTCT, FP and TB diagnosis. HIV positive clients will be referred to ART centers for clinical screening, diagnosis and treatment of any HIV and AIDS defining diseases including OIs. Community-based adherence counselors will track individuals on ART to promote adherence and linkages to other care and support services.

Given the constraints on health service systems and challenging access to health care facilities, community- and home-based care are essential to expand delivery of care and support services for PLHA, their families and OVC. All services will adhere to national standards, including national minimum standards for maternal and pediatric care, and for community and home based care.

Volunteers/community health workers (V/CHW) will provide community-based social and prevention services. These personnel will mainly build the capacity of community-based home care providers and mobilize PLHA to form support groups and link members to other care and support programs within the community. V/CHW will implement a comprehensive community health package for PLHA. The package includes malaria prevention, messaging on safe water, hygiene and food and nutrition, and referrals to facility-based care to reduce morbidity and mortality. The USG will work with district social workers and CSOs to provide community-based psychological and spiritual support including group and individual counseling, mental health services and end-of-life and bereavement support.

Food and nutrition support in Zambia will follow the PEPFAR recommended nutrition assessment, counseling and support (NACS) model. In FY 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will introduce a food-by-prescription program targeting PLHA and OVC. The model links PLHA and OVC to standardized food baskets to promote better nutrition and food security. Entry points include antenatal care (ANC), clinical referrals from HIV and AIDS care and treatment, maternal and child health (MCH) services, and community



nutrition groups.

Funding for OVC programs in COP 2011 increased by 12.6 percent (\$2.4 million) from COP 2010. The funding was shifted from abstinence and be faithful (AB) and adult care and support programs. In COP 2011, the PEPFAR Zambia OVC program will continue to prioritize both family-centered and community based interventions for OVC care. The program will strengthen the continuum of care for OVC including basic education, girls' scholarships, targeted food and nutrition support, legal aid and psychosocial support. Efforts include engagement with the private sector and civil society to expand social service support for OVC. Operations research on OVC programs will build Zambia's knowledge base on the needs of OVC and their caretakers to support evidence-based planning and to better target resources. In COP 2011, PEPFAR will reach 375,069 children below 18 years of age with a minimum of one care service.

The USG will continue to support the MOH goal of integrating TB and HIV services. All TB patients are tested and counseled for HIV; and HIV patients are screened for TB. With support from PEPFAR, the National TB and Leprosy Control Program (NTP) is implementing guidelines to effectively manage TB/HIV co-infection. The USG will continue to support the transportation of specimens to government laboratories and as well as other efforts to strengthen the TB laboratory network such as training of laboratory personnel in smear microscopy, including sputum collection and transportation and preparation and reading of slides. Redacted. PEPFAR Zambia will link co-infected individuals to care and support services such as post test clubs, hospices, hospitals, and support groups for PLHA for continued care and support. The USG will also support Zambia to implement intensified TB case finding through community involvement.

Treatment

The GRZ is committed to ensuring universal access to treatment. This will entail increased roll out of ART services to more health facilities coupled with adequate human and infrastructure resources to ensure that supply meets demand for this therapy. The USG funded adult treatment and care program provides a comprehensive package including pre and post test counseling, provision of ART, nutritional information and support, and palliative and home based care. PEPFAR Zambia supports a national network of ART outreach sites including urban and rural public and faith-based health facilities as well as mobile units to increase ART access. PEPFAR Zambia will continue to assist the ART site accreditation system to assess capacity to deliver ART according to national standards. Additional activities include ensuring an optimal continuum of care from pre-ART to ART eligibility; improving adherence to ART (maximizing the prevention benefit of ART); and increasing linkages between ART and other program areas such as TB and home-based care.

Zambia's 2011 COP balances the need to support the Zambian government's pursuit of universal access to treatment with fiscal funding realities. The Zambian commitment to raise the CD4 threshold for initiating treatment to 350 will create challenges for an already stretched health service delivery system. The national ARV requirement is approximately \$88.8 million in 2011 under the new CD4 350 threshold. Because PEPFAR Zambia's treatment partners work almost exclusively in government facilities, the country team determined that the USG would contribute up to 40 percent of the overall estimated requirement of ARV costs in COP 2011. PEPFAR Zambia does not expect the support for ARVs in COP 2012 and beyond to exceed USD \$40 million per year. COP 2011 contributions will remain stable for lab and test kit commodities. PEPFAR Zambia will maintain funding for treatment services (adult and pediatric) in 2011. PEPFAR Zambia will support ongoing cohort studies and drug quantification projections to further inform treatment program costs.

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Pediatric care and treatment (P-ART) programs funded by the USG encompass health services for HIV-exposed and HIV-infected children. To promote HIV-free infant survival, the GRZ and the USG are pursuing greater integration of pediatric clinical and community service delivery efforts. Despite efforts to improve PMTCT services, links between PMTCT and P-ART still need strengthening. Areas for support under COP 2011 include referrals and retention in care for pediatric cases; better monitoring and support of the growth and nutritional status of HIV-exposed infants; improved pediatric adherence support; improved treatment and prevention of OIs; and linkages to child survival interventions such as immunization. PEPFAR Zambia will also continue to support the expansion of the community-led integrated management of childhood illnesses (IMCI). This equips community health workers with skills for the early identification and management of childhood illnesses and appropriate referral to TC and P-ART services.

Strategic Information

Health Management Information Systems: During the coming year, PEPFAR Zambia and the GRZ will strengthen current health management information systems (HMIS) so that they are well integrated, sustainable, and locally owned. Zambia has developed a strong national electronic medical record (SmartCare) that assists in providing continuity of care for ART and TB patients, links test results in VCT clients and is deployed in over 500 health facilities. This is linked to HMIS and logistics management systems. Laboratory information systems will be developed in FY 2011. Data use from these systems will be strengthened to better measure health outcomes and impact, particularly for treatment and PMTCT activities. In COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will strengthen curriculum and teaching in data use in pre-service training institutions to ensure that graduates from these institutions are better equipped with the skills necessary to implement and use health information systems.

Monitoring and Evaluation: In recognition of the need to regularly monitor and evaluate partner performance, PEPFAR Zambia conducted a robust interagency portfolio review in FY 2010. A total of 72 local and GRZ partners participated in this process. There were many lessons learned that aided the development of the COP 2011. Programmatically, the portfolio review recommended an increased emphasis on TC for discordant couples, condom use and PwP.

To improve program performance, PEPFAR Zambia conducts routine visits to select project sites to monitor and follow up on program implementation, review and analyze quarterly reports, identify challenges and barriers to success and to recommend corrective actions. Both public health evaluations and country specific evaluations will include early mortality in TB, transactional sex and combination prevention.

Surveillance and surveys: PEPFAR Zambia will continue to strengthen the GRZ's ability to implement HIV-related surveys and surveillances. In FY 2011, the GRZ, with PEPFAR support, is planning a bi-annual antenatal sentinel surveillance activity and will compare this with PMTCT data. Mortality surveillance using SAVVY methodology will continue. The USG team and the GRZ will jointly plan for and/or implement a national population-based survey with biomarkers, including HIV, CD4 and STIs, to describe progress and gaps in health services coverage.

Health Systems Strengthening

Joint USG and GRZ efforts since 2004 have resulted in significant improvements in Zambian health system capacity to respond to the needs of Zambians. Building on past PEPFAR achievements, COP 2011 investments will improve the quality and capacity of direct service delivery. During COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will focus on a number of priority activities across the six health systems building blocks that will strengthen capacity and promote country ownership and sustainability.

Service delivery: PEPFAR Zambia will continue to support the GRZ's health worker retention scheme in remote areas to assure the availability of skilled health providers. As part of the retention strategy, and to enhance sustainability, the USG will scale down payments of retention allowances and scale up support



for improvements in health facilities and staff housing, such as clean water supply, solar panels, communication, medical and laboratory equipment and supplies.

Laboratory systems:

In COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will continue to support the GRZ to strengthen key areas of the laboratory system. Quality assurance management systems, including ongoing national external quality assessment programs for HIV rapid testing, TB diagnosis, CD4 enumeration, and expansion to cover other tests such as chemistry and hematology will be supported. Programs continue to emphasize strengthening laboratory management towards accreditation using the WHO Regional Office for Africa (WHO-Afro) step-wise process. PEPFAR Zambia will also support equipment maintenance systems to ensure uninterrupted laboratory services. The USG will continue to support other areas such as an energy program to ensure reliable and affordable power at laboratory facilities; strengthening polymerase chain reaction laboratory testing to ensure quality, timely, and reliable early infant diagnosis; and strengthening the Biomedical Society of Zambia to improve the standard of laboratory professionals.

Human resources: PEPFAR Zambia will continue to work with health worker training institutions to ensure inclusion of state of the art HIV prevention, care and treatment information in pre-service and in-service curricula. PEPFAR Zambia will support the development of infrastructure at targeted training institutions (medical, biomedical, nursing and clinical officer schools) in order to improve the quality of the training offered as well as increase the intake of students. PEPFAR Zambia is one of three countries included in the Nursing Education Partnership Initiative.

Given the small population and limited through-put at training facilities, it will be challenging for Zambia to contribute significantly to increased numbers of new health care workers (doctors, nurses and midwives) in pursuit of the global goal to train 140,000 health care providers. Zambia, however, has the potential to contribute larger numbers of community health workers, para-social workers and other types of non-clinical service providers. In select pilot districts, PEPFAR Zambia will support the GRZ's efforts to implement a Community Health Worker (CHW) program to mitigate the severe human resource crisis the country is experiencing. The program emphasizes task shifting of treatment, care and support services from facility-based health care workers to CHWs.

Quality improvement: PEPFAR Zambia emphasizes quality improvement and quality assurance across all aspects of programming. PEPFAR works closely with the GRZ to incorporate state of the art protocols and guidelines for HIV and AIDS prevention, treatment and care in all national guidelines and strategies. Work in blood safety and laboratory technology for testing and diagnosis, for example, meet international standards. PEPFAR places significant focus on health care provider training and ensuring that provider competencies meet established standards and criteria. In COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will continue to emphasize quality improvement and will ensure the implementation of quality assurance measures.

Medical commodities and technologies: PEPFAR Zambia partners will strengthen the national health logistics system and related procurement efforts with the goal of enhancing sustainability. Following the successful pilot of a new essential medicine supply chain system, PEPFAR Zambia partners, the GRZ and other key stakeholders such as the World Bank, are discussing scale up options. In COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will continue to support the expansion of laboratory and other health information technology and cater for equipment needs in targeted provincial and district health facilities. Finally, PEPFAR Zambia will continue to support cost analysis studies of ART to better enable sustainability planning.

Finance: Upon completion of the audits and investigations into GRZ funds misappropriation and better problem definition, the USG may provide technical assistance and support for improvement of financial management systems in the MOH, and has articulated this possibility in the draft GRZ/USG Partnership Framework.



Adoption of Global Health Initiative (GHI) Core Principles in Zambia

The GHI core principles offer exciting opportunities in Zambia. Several are already integrated into the portfolio. These include:

- Leadership and governance
- Woman and girl-centered approach
- Engagement and leveraging non-USG resources (the private sector and multilaterals)
- Increasing impact through strategic coordination and integration

A) Leadership and Governance

In Zambia, the National HIV/AIDS/STI/TB Council (NAC) and the Ministry of Health (MOH) lead the charge to mitigate the impact of HIV and AIDS and foster a nation free from the threat of HIV and AIDS. High-level government engagement, national leadership and continued ownership of the response by the GRZ are central to an effective national HIV and AIDS response. The GRZ, via the MOH and the NAC, will mobilize other ministries to support the national HIV and AIDS program and will outline required resources to ensure full implementation of the program. The GRZ will take the lead to establish financial accountability systems to ensure that such systems are functional and responsive to an increasing resource envelope.

The USG subscribes to the “Three Ones” and will continue to partner with the GRZ and other stakeholder to realize program goals and to mobilize technical support and the resources necessary for an effective HIV and AIDS response. The next phase of PEPFAR places greater emphasis on strengthening national health systems, including the health care workforce. It also focuses on enhancing partnerships with governments to strengthen country ownership and build capacity for a long-term and sustainable nationally-led response.

The USG, in collaboration with other donors, is providing technical support to the GRZ in the development of Zambia’s *Sixth National Development Plan 2011-2015* and the associated *NHSP 2011-2015* and the *NASF 2011-2015*. These plans provide the framework for program implementation through the remainder of the PEPFAR authorization period; and form the basis for the GRZ/USG Partnership Framework and associated Implementation Plan. Leadership and governance interventions are a major component of the GRZ/USG Partnership Framework.

B) Woman and Girl-Centered Approaches

PEPFAR Zambia addresses gender equity as an integral part of its support for HIV and AIDS prevention, care and treatment. Priorities include the promotion of couples TC, engaging women’s partners in PMTCT, advocating against harmful social/gender norms, screening and counseling for GBV; and assessing and identifying gender norms that support HIV risk behaviors. Programming will target community mobilization, provision of post exposure prophylaxis (PEP) to rape victims, and the promotion of healthy male norms and male-friendly HIV and AIDS services. Efforts to expand family centered care and treatment and to increase male involvement in HIV prevention programs will continue.

Methods to increase access to information, education and communication that address the unique needs of women and men include national campaigns, business and life skills training for girls and women, male and female condom distribution, and behavioral change programs for men.

PEPFAR Zambia will continue to promote economic empowerment of women and girls and link them to community micro-finance initiatives and education. PEPFAR Zambia will support programs involving men, boys and traditional leaders, as agents of change to address gender norms and protect women from violence. In partnership with the GRZ, the private sector and CSOs, 2011 programs will strengthen and expand support services for women who are victims of GBV.

PEPFAR Zambia will also continue to support programs promoting policy and legislation on the protection



of women's and children's rights as they relate to health, economic empowerment, and protection from GBV and HIV and AIDS. PEPFAR Zambia will participate in regular gender dialogue to influence integration of gender in various developmental programs. In addition, in COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will support programs that recognize and address the different needs and vulnerabilities of OVC girls and boys.

C) Engagement and Leveraging Non-USG Resources

PEPFAR Zambia supports a number of ongoing activities with the Zambian private sector. These include public-private partnership (PPP) activities with Zambia's largest industrial and service sectors, such as working with the tourism sector, particularly around Victoria Falls in Livingstone; and cooperation with the mining and agriculture sectors through ongoing HIV prevention, care, and treatment activities in six provinces. Additional activities include a PPP focused on laboratory training with Becton-Dickenson; a PPP with the Merck Foundation for a management and leadership program involving both HIV and non-HIV funding; and activities with a number of local banks with international ties. In all, activities leverage private sector interest to ensure a healthy workforce, and healthy communities.

Untapped PPP opportunities remain. Redacted. In addition, more than one percent of the 2011 COP program budget has been set aside for continuing and new activities to further strengthen private sector engagement in Zambia's HIV and AIDS response. PEPFAR Zambia partners will continue to engage private sector actors on HIV and AIDS issues, building institutional capacity and the country's capability to manage the epidemic.

D) Increasing Impact Through Strategic Coordination and Integration

PEPFAR Zambia supports a range of activities that are increasingly integrated and coordinated, leading to greater and more efficient impact. In COP 2011, PEPFAR implementing partners working in communities will distribute bed nets procured through the USG's President's Malaria Initiative (PMI) with funding from the USG and U.K. Department for International Development (DFID) funding. Many new PEPFAR Zambia implementing partners have contractual mandates for coordination and collaboration, which has led to greater program coordination. Services that are non-HIV funded such as FP and MCH will continue to be integrated with services for HIV infected and affected populations to ensure more comprehensive and better patient care for PLHA. For example, FP service availability, with an increased emphasis on PwP and community level delivery, is expanding using non-HIV funds.

In COP 2011, PEPFAR Zambia will continue to integrate the principles of GHI into health sector programming. Since 2004 PEPFAR-funded activities have improved ANC infrastructure as part of PMTCT programming. An estimated 93 percent of all pregnant women attend antenatal care at least once during pregnancy, providing a strong platform for FP counseling, management of malaria in pregnancy, TB diagnosis and treatment and referral to other MCH services such as nutrition counseling and immunizations for other children. PMTCT and ART are offered in MCH clinics. In COP 2011, activities will focus on ensuring that ART is offered to all HIV-infected pregnant women according to national guidelines.

In FY 2011, the GRZ and partners will promote the integration of MCH care into HIV and AIDS support and vice versa to ensure that families are accessing more comprehensive health care services. In the coming year, HIV and reproductive health program integration will be given considerable attention. The integration of FP counseling into male circumcision services and ANC as part of PMTCT are areas with great potential.

A new program, integrating HIV and non-HIV funds, focuses on leadership and management skills within the health workforce, which are key components of successful organizations.

Summary

As emphasized in the *NHSP 2011-2015* and the *NASF 2011-2015*, the GRZ is committed to reducing the rate of new HIV infections by 50 percent by 2015. PEPFAR Zambia is a committed partner in the fight against HIV and AIDS in Zambia. The USG will work more closely with the GRZ, other cooperating partners, and key stakeholders to support GRZ ownership and leadership and to build a sustainable platform for action. In this next year, the USG will continue to partner with the GRZ, the private sector and civil society to implement evidence-based and innovative programs in prevention, care and treatment. The integration of HIV and AIDS services with other basic health care services will receive special attention to ensure a more comprehensive approach to programming and to expand the reach of critical HIV services. PEPFAR investments will continue to target health systems strengthening to ensure a long-term and sustainable national response.

Overview Narrative

Lusaka Provincial Health Office (LPHO) is an auxiliary wing of Ministry of Health (MOH), Zambia whose unique mandate is to perform core public health activities. The office provides technical support to districts within the province namely Chongwe, Kafue, Luangwa and Lusaka in the delivery and management of health services which include: planning, priority-setting and optimal use of available resources. The mandate of Lusaka PHO includes data collection and its management, staff training, and policy advocacy. All non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and other agencies conducting health-related activities in the province work in collaboration with PHO. Lusaka Province has eighty (80) government health centers, three (3) district hospitals, and two (2) tertiary hospitals but has no general/secondary hospital(s). The province has two hundred and fifteen (215) private health facilities. All of these institutions offer either diagnostic services or both diagnostic and treatment services for Tuberculosis (TB) but anti-retroviral therapy (ART) services are not easily accessible outside Lusaka District. Lusaka Province has the highest HIV/AIDS prevalence rate in the country at 21% (Zambia Demographic Health Survey, 2007). The province notifies about one third of the total tuberculosis patients in the country (16,626 out of 47,000 in 2008). Seventy percent of these patients are HIV



infected. PHO implements the STOP TB strategy for TB and TB/HIV control. Country estimates show that only about 10% of the population know their HIV status. The province is implementing different strategies to enhance counseling and testing, including community sensitization, provider initiated counseling and testing, and are moving towards strengthening couples counseling. The MOH has recognized male circumcision as one of the effective preventive strategies for HIV, so a policy direction has been issued to roll out this strategy to all districts in the country. Through capacity building workshops for staff, mentoring, and onsite supervision, PHO will address the limited capacity to diagnose and treat opportunistic infections in many facilities in the province. In order to strengthen the laboratory network and quality assurance program, we will support districts with infrastructure development, transport and logistics to facilitate on-site supervision, training and specimen collection to laboratories. Additionally, we will facilitate procurement of laboratory equipment, reagents and other supplies. In an effort to improve case detection by laboratory diagnosis, microscopists will be trained. Promoting effective and efficient use of resources, we will ensure integration of programs in the districts and coordinate partner programs in the province. Improvements in data and information management will be facilitated by LPHOs procurement of a broadband communication facility and employ of a data associate at PHO. LPHO will prepare and submit quarterly and annual reports to the MOH. LPHO will support districts to conduct monthly supportive supervisory visits to facilities. Districts will prepare and submit monthly and quarterly reports to the province. LPHO and the districts will hold quarterly program performance review meetings.

Lusaka Provincial Health Office (LPHO) will train health workers in psychosocial counseling, community volunteers in lay counseling and rapid HIV testing. Couples counseling will be strengthened in the districts through community sensitization and orientation to health workers on the need to provide counseling to couples. Sensitization messages will continue through various forms of media such as drama and information, education, and communication (IEC) materials to the target population. For continuous improvement of the counseling environment, LPHO will invest in minor infrastructure development in two sites in each of the three districts. We will provide technical supportive supervision on a quarterly basis with a view to mentoring district supervisors and building supervisory capacity to ensure quality of counseling and testing services. We will monitor district activities in couples counseling through monthly and quarterly reports and quarterly performance review meetings.

LPHO will also support the implementation of the SmartCare testing and counseling (TC) module. \$75,000, of the \$205,000 total amount, is provided to help assure training and oversight for the SmartCare TC module implementations, at all TC sites.

In order to improve data and information management, LPHO will facilitate procurement of a broadband communication facility - Very Small Aperture Terminal (VSAT) to provide linkages between the districts and the provincial health office. This is intended to enhance timely reporting and submission of data as well as general management of computer security in updating the antivirus software over the internet. LPHO will use this facility to disseminate updates and other communications for various programs. A data associate will be employed at LPHO whose responsibility will include collection and collation of TB, HIV/AIDS, ART, PMTCT, VCT and laboratory data and technical support to district staff. The data associate will also support the management of the SmartCare installations in Lusaka Province.

To provide enhanced PMTCT and ART services to positive mothers, SmartCare will be deployed in at least 80% of the sites offering PMTCT, which have sufficient electricity.

LPHO will improve the quality of SmartCare facility data through performance review meetings and supervisory activities. Likewise, LPHO will support DHIOs to collect, verify and timely report to the

provincial health office and ensure that old and new health staff are competent to correctly and accurately record, analyze and report health data using SmartCare to support the HMIS system.

LPHO will provide leadership in expanding male circumcision (MC) services to Kafue and Luangwa districts in addition to Chongwe. A rapid survey will be conducted in Kafue and Luangwa districts to assess attitudes, beliefs, practices and socio-cultural aspects of MC. LPHO will advocate for community involvement by engaging community leaders such as traditional rulers and other opinion leaders to mobilize communities for MC services. LPHO will facilitate human resource development through on-site and didactic training of staff and work with districts to develop district implementation plans for MC activities. Renovation of existing infrastructure in order to conform to national standards for MC services will also be facilitated by LPHO; further, we will support furnishing of buildings and procurement of equipment and supplies. We will link MC activities to HIV counseling and testing services in all facilities in order to contribute to risk reduction in contracting HIV infection. Lusaka Provincial Health Office (LPHO) will support and build capacity in districts in order to collaborate with stakeholders in TB/HIV control to expand community education and awareness regarding STIs and the risk they pose for HIV infection. In order to promote sustainability and lasting behavior change, we will support STI services as part of regular health services provided by the district health teams. LPHO will build capacity in all four districts of Lusaka, Chongwe, Kafue and Luangwa. LPHO will support health

education talks to include STI prevention and treatment seeking behavior. LPHO has a goal of improving the capacity of laboratories to provide effective and efficient quality laboratory services in order to enhance diagnosis and patient monitoring in HIV/AIDS/TB/STI related conditions. To meet the goal, LPHO will support selected laboratories to acquire laboratory accreditation. LPHO will initiate and conduct accreditation process(es) with MOH and CDC. We will support and ensure quality of all laboratories testing including HIV, build capacity of laboratory personnel through various trainings which will be undertaken in collaboration with MOH, CDC and other partners. In addition, We will support thirty laboratory staff to attend in-country training courses in lab accreditation, laboratory management, quality assurance (QA), basic computer skills, laboratory accreditation, phlebotomy, equipment maintenance, and lab information system.

LPHO trained 93 health workers in TB/HIV integration, 45 in provider-initiated testing and counseling and 100 treatment supporters in TB/HIV activities. Counseling and testing of TB patients for HIV increased from 54% in 2007 to 60% in FY 2008. In order to strengthen mechanisms for collaboration between TB and HIV programs, we will continue supporting provincial and district coordinating body activities and establish health center and community level bodies.

Training in intensified TB case finding in Anti-retroviral Therapy (ART), Voluntary Counseling and Testing (VCT), Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) and antenatal clinics will be conducted, in order to reduce the burden of TB in HIV infected individuals. In addition, we will train microscopists and orient staff to improve case detection by laboratory diagnosis. Health workers will be trained in TB infection control and ensure TB infection control measures at facility levels. LPHO will continue supporting the employment of four clinicians and TB/HIV coordinator(s) to improve on the shortage of staff.

Coordination of partner activities and oversight of trained health workers as well as refresher trainings and/or technical updates for selected health workers in TB/HIV clinical management will continue. Provider initiated counseling in TB clinics and OPD for both suspects and confirmed TB patients will be maintained and support will be offered to districts in strengthening linkages and referral systems from TB to HIV services. TB/HIV co-infected patients will be encouraged to use condoms, notify partners and linked to support groups of people living with HIV/AIDS for continued care and support. We will strengthen Multi-Drug Resistant TB (MDR) surveillance in the districts by supporting specimen courier systems to laboratories. LPHO will continue to support income generating activities for community volunteers to motivate them, identify TB suspects, and care for patients on treatment. LPHO will continue to conduct technical support and quarterly TB/HIV data review meetings using MOH approved data collection and reporting tools.

Overview Narrative

Goal: To support HIV/AIDS/STI and TB prevention, care and treatment among underserved populations in the six districts of Eastern Province in order to ultimately reduce transmission of HIV/AIDS/STI.

In the FY 2011, CARE will expand to 115 from 90 communities. CARE will continue improve access to and delivery of HIV/AIDS services by strengthening activities aimed at creating demand for TB/HIV/PMTCT and CT services in the six districts and also to address the challenges on client follow ups, TB case finding, contact tracing, TB DOTS, ART adherence, follow up of exposed infants and testing in those districts.

Partnership

Under partnership ITAP 2 will build on lessons learnt in FY 2010 in strengthening community health systems and ability to tap community channels for referral, linkage and communication beyond the formal health system. Neighborhood Health Committees (NHCs) and trained volunteers including Community Health Workers (CHWs) are the main community structures to be tapped and supported.

No significant changes are expected.

PMTCT and Linkages with Maternal Child Health and Family Planning

In FY 2011, ITAP 2 will contribute 10% (3, 500) through referrals of pregnant women by trained volunteers and other support groups in the community of the targeted 35,000 pregnant women with known HIV status (includes women who were tested and received their results) in the six districts.

Other changes will include capacity building of community based distributors to increase unmet needs in family planning especially in HIV positive clients.

Cross cutting issues

ITAP 2 in FY 2011 will largely involve participation of males, traditional leaders and local marriage counselors in addressing gender inequities such as polygamy, early marriages, and the perception of women as obedient sexual partners, leading to increased vulnerabilities for women



No significant changes will be made from what was proposed in FY 2010.

Monitoring and Evaluation

ITAP 2 in FY 2011, will build on lessons learnt during FY 2010 implementation to strengthen Monitoring and Evaluation based on community mobilization, community based information system and strengthened community structures. In addition, documentation of internal assessment findings, lessons learnt and best practices on Community mobilization will be prioritized to enhance evidence based for future programming.

Overview Narrative

While scale-up of HIV care and Anti-retroviral treatment (ART) has been rapid, with nearly 250,000 Zambians currently on ART, HIV prevention has not shown the same success and more adults become infected each year than are placed on ART. HIV prevalence in pregnant women was highest in 1994 at 20%, but declined only to 19% in 2004 and 17% in 2007/8. Two population-based DHS+ surveys have been completed, with HIV prevalence in the general adult population of 16.3% in 2001/2 and 14.3% in 2007. Women have higher prevalence than men (16.1% vs. 12.3%), and rates in urban areas are double that of rural (19.7% vs. 10.3%). While declines in HIV prevalence are substantial in the 20-29 year age groups in women and the 25-34 year age groups in men, young people make up the majority of new cases of HIV. Despite reaping the immediate benefits of rapid scale-up of HIV prevention and treatment initiatives, Zambia's HIV prevalence has stabilized at high levels (14.3%). The epidemic among Zambia's 12.9 million residents is driven by heterosexual transmission. It is estimated that 71% of new infections in the future will occur in people with non-regular sexual partners and 21% in people with one reported sexual partner. The major drivers of the Zambian HIV epidemic include: Multiple and Concurrent Sexual Partners (MCP); low and inconsistent condom use; low levels of Male Circumcision (MC); mobility and labor migration; vulnerability among most-at-risk populations (such as sex workers and in male-to-male sexual relationships); and vertical transmission from mother to child (MTCT). Furthermore, underlying social factors and behaviors such as alcohol abuse, gender inequality, beliefs about male dominance and sexuality, gender-based violence (GBV) and sexual coercion, taboos and barriers regarding couple communication about sex, trans-generational and transactional sex further fuel the epidemic.

To date, prevention efforts have been concentrated in urban areas and have achieved moderate success. Zambian prevention programs must also focus more on targeting their efforts to the most geographically-needy areas in the country. Though urban HIV prevalence is declining, rural prevalence is rising. The epidemiological challenges in Zambia necessitate an intervention that addresses the underlying issues that prevent the utilization of community level interventions in high-prevalence areas. HIV prevention programs have tended to reach out to urban populations, without seeking the buy-in of local communities in designing and shaping their HIV prevention efforts. A program that motivates communities to own their HIV prevention efforts, reaches out to the most vulnerable and provides community incentives to drive the achievement of HIV prevention would be a useful addition to ongoing Zambian prevention efforts. Catholic Medical Mission Board (CMMB), working with its partner the Society for Family Health (SFH), will implement a comprehensive, community-based HIV prevention project among the most underserved



districts in Western Province. However during fiscal year 2011, FSH will not be a sub-partner, but as resources become available in subsequent years SFH will be part of the consortium to provide Voluntary Medical Male Circumcision services. The project approach is informed by CMMB and SFH's extensive experience in successfully mobilizing and engaging communities in HIV prevention programs that better health-seeking behaviors. The project will increase the uptake of targeted community-level HIV prevention interventions through Community Compacts - agreements that incentivize comprehensive community-based prevention efforts that reduce the spread of HIV. Targeted communities will establish Compact agreements with the project to work toward achieving prevention goals that increase uptake of HIV prevention activities. The project will strengthen the HIV prevention initiatives at community level with linkages to health facilities and will implement its strategy in close collaboration with the Provincial Health Offices (PHOs) and District Health Management Teams (DHMTs). The initial targeted districts include Kaoma, Mongu and Lukulu with combined total population of 503,003.

The Project defines Compact Communities as residents of a catchment area of health facilities in targeted districts, due to Zambians' close identification with their local health facility. The Project will promote Men Taking Action (MTA) initiative, CT services targeting couples, and PwP. The strategy will involve establishment of Community Compact Committees for each health facility catchment area. The Committees will comprise: health facilities staff; community leaders including chiefs, village headmen, herbalists; Traditional Birth Attendants (TBAs); the clergy; civic leaders; Community Health Workers (CHW); and members of Neighborhood Health Committees (NHCs). The Project will also seek support from the Community AIDS Task Forces (CATFs), the District AIDS Task Forces (DATFs) and the Provincial AIDS Task Forces (PATFs). This approach will ensure a strong foundation for buy-in by communities.

CMMB will develop an M&E system that captures relevant data from the Project, providing the appropriate tools and training for community workers (CHW, TBAs, FSWs, traditional community leaders and supervisors).
